Tishrei	September/October	Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, Sukkot, Simhat Torah
<u>H</u> eshvan	October/November	
Kislev	November/December	<u>H</u> anukah
Tevet	December/January	
Shvat	January/February	Tu B'Shvat
Adar*	February/March	Purim
Nisan	March / April	<u>P</u> esah
Iyar	April/May	Lag B'Omer
Sivan	May/June	Shavuot
Tamuz	June/July	
Av	July/August	
Elul	August/September	

\* A Jewish leap year has two months of Adar: Aleph and Bet. In a leap year, Purim is in Adar Bet.
